

POLICY ON UNIFORM

The uniform is only available from Mullion Post Office – Tel. No. 01326 240223

All The students wear a light blue polo shirt which has the school logo. The school sweatshirt can be worn over this. It is a dark, navy blue round-neck and it also has the school logo. In warm weather the polo shirt only is worn. In cooler weather both items are worn by students. (There is therefore no need for any other garments such as T-shirts or cardigans as these are **not** part of the uniform).

Shoes - black - as flat a heel as possible and for health and safety reasons not over 6.5 cms high. (all black trainers can be worn but not skate shoes or skate trainers).

Skirts and Trousers are Black

Boys Boys wear black trousers designed for school (see below).

Girls Girls wear black trousers or skirts designed for school. Skirts that are below the ankle and mini-skirts are not allowed for health and safety reasons. This is at the Headteacher's discretion. This is a point of much conflict with teenage daughters. If you, as a parent, are in any doubt about the suitability of a skirt, or indeed any item of uniform:

(a) Keep the receipt.

(b) Ask the Headteacher to give you an opinion about the item. If the item is unsuitable, unworn and you have the receipt, retailers will refund you the cost.

The trousers for both boys and girls must be wool/polyester, cotton/polyester material not elastic fabric, so leggings or track-suit trousers are not suitable. They must be designed for school (no denims).

Hairstyle/Make-Up Extravagant styles or colours **are not** permitted in school. Discreet make-up is permitted.

Jewellery allowed 1 watch, 1 ring. Earrings – only one stud in one ear/each ear (not two in one ear – stud must be small). Nose studs, eyebrow rings and bolts, tongue piercings and other body piercings **are not** permitted in school. They present enormous health and safety issues. No visible neck jewellery. Items of religious, cultural or sentimental importance may be worn out of sight, under the polo-shirt.

This policy is reviewed by the staff and MSA at least once a year. The School Council are also invited to comment.
