

RE: Year 8 Bodmin Jail Excursion

Dear Parents and Carers,

To tie in with our unit of work on Gothic Literature, we are offering our year 8 students the opportunity to visit Bodmin Jail on Tuesday 12th February 2019.

The jail has to be one of the best untapped learning resources in the county with its dark history of inmates, executions and hauntings. During the visit, students will be given a guided tour and be told some of the ghost stories and legends associated with the site. We hope this will help our students to engage more deeply with the Gothic Literature we study in lessons and also to inspire their own creative writing.

Coaches will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and aim to return in time for the school buses at the end of the day. Students attending must wear sensible clothing, bring a waterproof coat and a packed lunch.

The trip is being offered to the whole year group, but there are only 45 spaces available. As spaces are limited, places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Students must return the attached slip and signed consent form along with payment to reception.

The cost to include entry, the guided tour and travel will be £15.00 per place, and this must come to school in an envelope marked with the trip name 'Bodmin Jail' and the pupil's name and form, to be handed in to the office. Cheques should be made payable to Mullion School and also have the pupil's name and the trip name on the back. There is some funding available to financially support places on the trip for those that meet criteria; please contact me if you would like further information about this.
