

COVID GUIDANCE

Students should not be in school if they are symptomatic (or as long as they have symptoms) . For further guidance parents can copy and paste to the following website:

There are also mobile test units which travel around the County and it has been confirmed that there is one at Falmouth Rugby Club although for how long we do not know but you would need to book via the Government website. It is important for you to register your home kit online as they have unique codes to you (**please read the instructions which come with the kit**) as you will receive a confirmation whether your test is negative or positive via email/phone.
