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Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, I hope that your child has had a positive return to Mullion after so many months away from the routine and rigour of studying in school. I wanted to give you all some clarity on how learning at home would look for your child under several different scenarios.

### **Home learning. Providing work for students who are self-isolating:**

Students who are at home self-isolating for 2 weeks (e.g someone in their household has coronavirus) or have tested positive for Coronavirus will receive an online education. Staff will be informed by the pastoral team or Attendance Officer of any student who is self-isolating and will then place work on Google Classroom or send electronic work home so that your child can follow their daily timetable. It may be that your child will follow their daily timetable a day later than students in school, because teachers will need some turnaround time to send the work. If a student contracts coronavirus and is relatively well or asymptomatic, work will be provided during their period of self-isolation, as per the detail above. If they are unwell, then they will not be required to complete any schoolwork. This will be agreed in liaison with parents. If a student is unwell with something other than Covid - 19 and is likely to be absent from school for a week or more, work will also be set on Google Classroom. Early notification that this is likely to be the case would be very useful in this scenario.

### **Home learning. Providing work for students who are in a year group lockdown/partial school closure/blended learning:**

During a partial school closure scenario, for example if a year group has to stay at home for a period of time as a result of advice from Public Health England, students who are at home will be taught via Google Classroom in a similar way as during the summer term. This will, in the main, follow the pattern of your child's normal timetable.

### **Home learning. Providing work for students during a full closure:**

In a full school closure scenario, again there will be a mix of teacher delivery and work placed on Google Classroom for students to engage in, similar to the method of working in the summer term.
