Dear Parents / Carers,

Students in Years 7 - 11 will receive Google Classroom based work from Tuesday 5th January. Students should log into Google Classroom for the lessons they would normally have on that day, work and resources for those subjects will be available from 9am.

As it stands we are expecting to reopen for all pupils after the February half term (Tuesday 23 February).

Students in Years 10 and 11 who are sitting real exams on the 11th January will receive a separate communication from Mr Holmes. The Government has stipulated that these exams will be going ahead as scheduled.

Vulnerable and Key Worker Children:

Vulnerable and Key Worker children will be able to return to school on Tuesday 5th January and on subsequent days. Pupils from all year groups will be supervised together in D9 where 2m social distancing, hygiene procedures, and ventilation will be maintained. Masks will continue to be required on buses and social areas of the school. They will not receive specific teaching over and above having access to the same online work their peers will be accessing from home.

If at all possible, and only if it is safe to do so, we advise parents of vulnerable and key worker children to keep their children at home wherever possible to reduce risk of transmission and to focus our work on the preparing for and then delivering the lateral flow tests. This will be of significant support to the staff team in achieving these aims.

Vulnerable and key worker children should not return to school if their parents have not booked them on the provision.
