POLICY ON UNIFORM

Information for Parents and Carers

Mullion School's uniform is designed to be comfortable, practical, hard wearing and, therefore, good value for money. If it's worn within the specification it also looks very smart.

Our uniform is purchased online from Price and Buckland and we keep sample sizes of all garments in school. Please phone our school office during term time to try on any samples. A sizing guide can also be found on our school website.

Please read our guidelines and policy carefully. Don't rely on uniform sections in our shops. Just because they are advertised as school garments, this does not necessarily mean that they are what we find acceptable.

Requirements for all students:

- Light blue polo shirt with the school logo. (Students in the summer term of Year 10 who are selected to be prefects will wear a red polo shirt).
- Dark blue school sweatshirt.

In cool weather, pupils wear both. In warmer weather, pupils may wear the polo shirt only. There should be no visible t-shirts or vests. PE kit cannot be worn instead of a polo shirt or sweatshirt.

- Completely black footwear with a heel less than 5cm high. NO logos, flashes or coloured laces. No boots above the ankle. POLISHABLE SHOES ARE PREFERRED. A trainer style shoe is acceptable.

Requirements for boys

On the 'Price and Buckland' website you will find a traditional school trouser for sale. You don't have to purchase this particular trouser from the website but any that you do buy must be very similar in style. They must be wool/polyester or cotton/polyester material and not elastic fabric, so leggings or tracksuit trousers are not acceptable. Denim is not acceptable. No studded pockets or contrast stitching. No skinny jeans. No combat trousers.

In warmer weather tailored shorts to the knee (traditional school shorts) are acceptable.

Requirements for girls

On the 'Price and Buckland' website you will find a 'preferred' school trouser and a 'preferred' pleated school skirt. It is not essential that they are purchased from the website but any that you do buy must be very similar in style. We have samples for you to try on in school. Contact our school office if you would like to try some on before ordering or consult the online sizing guide.

No leggings. No skinny jeans No trousers with studded pockets. Tailored shorts to the knee are acceptable in hot weather.

Socks worn with skirts must be white, blue or black. If tights are worn, they must be black or flesh coloured and smart. No rips or holes.

Hair styles/make-up

No extravagant hair styles or colours. Discreet hair slides, hair slides, hair bands and grips are permitted.

Pupils in Year 7,8 and 9 must not wear make-up. Pupils in Year 10 and 11 are permitted to wear discreet make-up.

Jewellery

1 watch and 1 ring. Earrings - 1 stud in one ear or one stud in each ear. Studs must be smaller than the ear lobe and discreet. Nose studs, eyebrow piercings, tongue piercings and other body piercings are not permitted. Neck jewellery must not be visible.

IMPORTANT FOR ALL...

If, for some reason, your child comes to school wearing an item of footwear or clothing that does not comply with our policy, please send them to school with a note explaining why there is a problem and when you hope to have the problem rectified by. We will issue your child with a 'uniform pass' for a period of time.
