ClassCharts Parent account and login details

Dear Parent / Carer,

'ClassCharts' is an exciting tool our staff are now using to monitor behaviour, publish homework tasks and to record the punctuality of submitting homework. We now feel comfortable enough in using some of these features so would like to invite you to create a parent account.

When you create an account, for the moment, you will be able to see:

- Homework tasks that have been published for your child and the submission date.
- Whether your son or daughter has 'submitted' the homework or whether it is 'pending' or 'late'. (It may take a couple of days for staff to record this after the submission date)
- Positive behavior points (merits). You will be able to see which member of staff has awarded the merit, for which reason and any accompanying notes the member of staff has written.

What you are not yet able to see, as we are still undergoing a trial period is:

- Any negative behaviour points - awarded when a pupil has to 'return to the teacher' because of low level unsatisfactory behaviour or substandard work
- Detentions

Enclosed is a unique code for your login and instructions about how to go about setting up your account.

I hope that ClassCharts enables you to feel better informed about these aspects of your child's schooling and I will let you know when and if further functions will be available to you.

Finally, in the very near future, we will be giving pupils to their own account too.
