Year 7 Catch-Up Numeracy and Literacy Plan

The numeracy and literacy catch-up grant gives schools additional funding to assist Year 7 pupils who are identified as needing support to progress to the same levels as their peers. The catch-up funding is designed to ensure that pupils, who have not achieved their potential at KS2, are not disadvantaged by this, and are provided with the same opportunity and equality to be successful learners.
